## 2020-2021 Full Day Kindergarten Tuition

### Payment Schedule

Please note the full-day kindergarten program in the Braintree Public Schools has a tuition fee associated with it. All families are expected to pay the tuition fee prior to the start of the school year. The tuition fee is **\$3500.00/year per child**. Should a family be eligible for reduced tuition based on the economically disadvantaged guidelines, the cost would be **\$1750.00/year per child**.

The payment schedule for full tuition or reduced tuition is as follows:

### Reduced Tuition Information and Paperwork to be Completed

#### General Information

Families with students who are eligible for SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program), Transitional Aid to Families with Dependent Children, MassHealth, and/or DCF Foster Care may be eligible for a reduced tuition based on the Economically Disadvantaged Guidelines. The **reduced tuition rate is \$1750.00 for the Full-Day Kindergarten program, with a reduced deposit of \$300.00, required by 2/28/20** to secure your child's spot.

#### Step I: Proof of Eligibility

**Families must provide proof of eligibility or participation at registration.** Copies of proof can be made at the time of registration. For Full-Day Kindergarten applicants, proof from one of the organizations listed below of your student's eligibility in one of these programs must accompany your child's registration *the day of registration*.

- ✓ SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)
- ✓ Transitional Aid to Families with Dependent Children
- ✓ MassHealth
- ✓ DCF Foster Care
- ✓ Free/Reduced Lunch Application/Share Form

#### Step II: Completing Free and Reduced Lunch Application

In addition to providing proof from one of the Economically Disadvantaged categories as listed above, the Braintree Public School requires all families applying for reduced tuition to complete the Free/Reduced Lunch Application and Share Form. **Please note, at this time, applying for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program is for the reduced tuition approval ONLY.** You will have to complete the Free and Reduced lunch application form **again in August for the 2020/2021** school year should you wish to receive free and/or reduced lunches for your child.

In order to be considered for reduced tuition, please complete the attached forms and return with any supporting documents by **2/7/20 to Sarah Coughlin** as noted below. Please note, due to confidentiality, the home schools cannot accept this information.
